Contest Details

WHO: ANY Butte County youth enrolled in K-12th grades.

WHAT: Design a logo that will be used to create the popular 2 inch "I Voted" sticker. *Must use "I Voted" Sticker Design Artwork document.* Artwork must be original—**NO** Trade-marked images, likenesses, or other materials in design. Design must include the phrase "I Voted". This is your chance to draw what voting means to you!

WHEN: Artwork can be submitted between May 1st – June 30th. The contest will end on *June 30, 2023 at 5:00pm.*
