Logic and Accuracy Testing

Tabulation equipment will be tested for logic and accuracy on May 3rd, at 9:00am.

Vote By Mail Processing

Starting on May 11th, voted ballot return envelope signatures will be verified against voter registration records.

June 1st will be the first day voted ballots returned as “good” will be opened and tabulated.

Election results will not be released until 8:15pm election night, June 7th. Semi-Unofficial Results will be released after 8:15pm via hardcopy, phone and on the website at www.ButteVotes.net.

Official Canvass

The official canvass process will begin June 8th and continue until complete.

One Percent Manual Tally Selection of Batches

At each election, one percent of the ballot batches shall be hand tallied. Random selection of batches will occur at 9:00am on June 13th.

The hand tally will begin June 13th at 10:00am and continue until complete.

Central Count

Butte County is a central count county. This means that all of the processes listed above will take place at the Hall of Records, 155 Nelson Avenue in Oroville, CA.
