STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION UPDATE

The Butte County Clerk-Recorder/Registrar of Voters office is in the process of conducting the official canvass for the June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election.

This process involves not only counting ballots, but also: auditing election results, verifying/curing challenged signatures on vote by mail envelopes, receiving mail in ballots postmarked by election day, receiving Butte County ballots submitted to other counties on time, as well as verifying and counting conditional and provisional envelopes.

If you receive a “cure letter” in the mail verifying/curing your challenged signature, you have until 5pm on June 22, 2022 to complete and submit your cure letter to the Butte County Elections Division.

The official canvass will continue until completed. California Elections Code provides that this process be completed within 30 days of the election. The Elections Division expects to have Butte County’s results certified (finalized) before the deadline.
